The following information is designed to allow one to get to the start of the named walk or tramp and supply a few facts and figures on times, distances and efforts involved. As this tramp is in the Coromandel the first step is to get yourself to the peninsula and then to Tairua or nearby.

How to get to START: From Tairua drive north on SH25 for approximately 4km to find firstly the junction to Pumpkin Hill Road then the one to Sailors Grave Road – both on the right. The road down to the beach is surfaced and perfectly safe though winding; there is ample parking overlooking the beach, where there are often waves suitable for gentle surfing and swimming. Once on the beach at Otara Bay there are quite a few birds (Doterrel) to be seen as is a fenced off nesting area.

There is then a short steep track on to the beach. Head north and the various tracks are easily found as there are signs. The ascents are not overly taxing with only a hundred metres to ascend on the biggest one but remember there are 4 ascents as you do have e to return. The return walk takes about 3hours.
